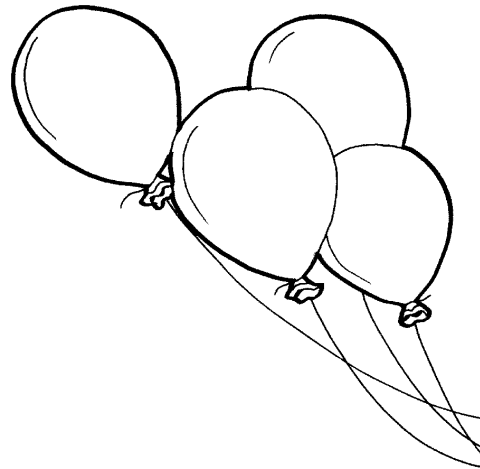

We also ask that everyone bring a side or dessert, potluck style.

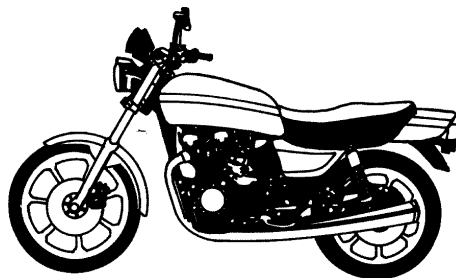
The Hall will provide setups and beer, so otherwise BYOB not including beer.
